- Sitka Gold Corp is a newly listed junior explorer focused on three drill ready projects; the Burro Creek Gold Project in Arizona, the Alpha Gold Project in Nevada, and the Coppermine River Project in Nunavut.

Burro Creek Property, Arizona

- Historical (2011) Indicated and Inferred resource deposit of 5 Moz silver and more than 100,000 oz gold
- 50 hole drilling program planned over a 1.0 mile strike length to expand deposit

- Carlin-type gold target near McEwen Mining's new Gold Bar Mine along prolific Battle Mtn-Eureka- Cortez gold trend in Nevada
- 12-hole drilling program permits secured from BLM

Coppermine River Project, Nunavut

- 125,000 acre land package with high grade samples up to 70% Cu.
- massive, under-explored district with potential to host world class stratiform sediment-hosted and volcanic-hosted copper deposits
- Exploration currently on hold due to land use uncertainty
